Waleed Al Hussein's home on Thursday, July 23, 2015 around 3:30 pm, searched the house and confiscated a laptop, tablet, and mobile phones, as well as Waleed's passport.

Sudan Human Rights Network (SHRN) believed that the reason underlying arrest of the Sudanese citizen Waleed Alhussain to be on the background of his work with website alrakoba.net, which reports on political and economic issues that is not necessarily supports policies of the Government of Sudan.

Sudan Human Rights Network is deeply concerned about the wellbeing of Waleed Alhussain, and urge Sudan Embassy in Riyadh to:

- Call on Saudi authorities to immediately and unconditionally release Waleed Alhussain, since no valid legal charges have been made
- Express their concern at the arrest and continuing of detention of Waleed Alhussain
- Requesting assurances that he is being humanly treated, that he has immediate and regular access to his family, lawyers, and any necessary medical attention.
